Metatopia Diversity Sponsorship

In cooperations with Double Exposure, the Indie Game Developer Network sponsors a scholarship to enable diverse game designers to attend Metatopia, the game design conference. The scholarship covers travel, lodging, and a badge so that designers can show off their games and make connections with industry professionals.

Indie Groundbreaker Awards

The Indie Groundbreaker Awards are held at GenCon each year. These awards recognize games (and game designers) who create new and exciting game designs that push the boundaries in innovation, in promoting diversity, and in expanding what it means to be "indie."

Mentorship Program

The IGDN offers a Mentorship Program for people who are interested in getting help with their game design, but aren't ready or don't wish to be full members of the IGDN. Mentees are paired with an appropriate mentor from the network and work together over a six month period.

Application Process

The IGDN is always looking for new members to diversify our ranks. The application processes can seem overwhelming so we've outlined what ours looks like for applicants.

- Once you email us our Membership Coordinator will send over an application.
- When we have your completed application it is sent to our membership for discussion.
- Then, we vote on your application and you're informed whether or not you've been accepted to join.
- You start off in the IGDN as a probationary member and after a 3 months the IGDN leadership will vote to make you a full member.

IGDN Membership costs \$100 per year. Probationary members are asked to pay \$50 to start and the balance once they're accepted as full members.
